CHRIST SHINING THROUGH THE KNIGHTS

In the face of every human being radiates that of Christ, who has admonished us to reach out to those in need. Christ remains invisibly present among us, because we are told in 1Cor. 15: 44-45; if there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual one. So, too, it is written, the first man, Adam, became a living being, the last Adam a lifegiving spirit. And Paul's Letter to the Galatians 2:20, says "I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me; insofar as I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God who has loved me and given himself up for me." Therefore, the activities and innovative but creative approach initiated and executed by the St. Pius X Knights of Columbus is a direct manifestation of the working of the Holy Spirit in and through each and every member. We are the hands, feet, eyes and ears of Christ within our Catholic community today. Ephesians 1:23 says 'He fills all things in every way,' and so through each member, Christ is extended within our space and time since "you are members of God's household," Ephesians 2:19.

In Paul's Letter to the Colossians 1:18, we read that Christ is the head of the body, the Church, He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things he might be preeminent. The letter to the Romans 12: 4-5 also says as in one body we have many parts, and all the parts do not have the same function, so we, though many are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another. This explains our role as Knights and why it manifests itself in different ways through our active participation within the Church family and community, and these roles do compliment each other to create the wholeness needed for the Church community. These roles go from working the grills during events, cleaning up, attending our common events and socializing with other guests; selling tickets for fund raising, making sure that messages get to other members in a timely fashion, taking up collections at mass as an usher, being a lector or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion and many more to be highlighted later.

The fact that we work together in these different ways within our Church community is a testimony of the power of love itself and the love of Christ dwelling within us. In my subsequent reflections I will throw more light into each of these areas of our ministry and its correlation to the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ that we have been called to share with our society.






